Position Summary

The Cook is a full-time permanent position in the Mino Ayaa Ta Win Healing Centre and includes light housekeeping duties. The Cook is responsible for meal planning, preparation and for supervising and maintaining the operation of the kitchen and dining facilities of the Mino Ayaa Ta Win Healing Centre. The Cook will ensure the overall cleanliness and sanitation of the kitchen and residence is regularly maintained.

Job Duties

- Maintains proper sanitary conditions in the cooking and dining areas;
- Plans and posts a weekly menu;
- Plans a weekly grocery list and purchases or arranges for the purchase of groceries under the supervision of the Mino Ayaa Ta Win Manager;
- Provides well-balanced and nutritious meals following the Canada Food Guide and Traditional Food Guide;
- Prepares dietary and traditional foods for residents on request;
- Ensures appropriate supplies and instructions for meal and snack preparation for evening and weekend shifts;
- Supervises residents in kitchen, cleaning & laundry duties;
- Assists occasionally in the supervision of residents at the request of the Mino Ayaa Ta Win Manager;
- Assists the Manager in budgeting for food, kitchen, dining, housekeeping, laundry and linens;
- Assists the Manager to prepare reports on food & housekeeping operations;
- Attends staff meetings as requested by Mino Ayaa Ta Win Manager.

Qualifications

- Food Handler's Certificate;
- Experience in commercial or institutional cooking and housekeeping;
- 2 years' experience in cooking for large groups, including preparation of meals for diabetics and others on special diets;
- Working knowledge of the Canada Food Guide;

- Must possess valid driver's license, clean driver's abstract, and be insurable
- Current updated immunization required
- Must possess current First Aid and CPR qualifications
- Employment is conditional upon successful completion of a vulnerable sector Criminal Records check
