The Construction Miner will be responsible for operating various equipment in a safe and appropriate manner. Equipment may include 100 Ton trucks, haul trucks, may front-end loaders, dozers, excavators, and other pieces of equipment. He or she must always perform circle checks of equipment and clean, maintain and secure all equipment as directed by legislation, policies and procedures.

The responsibilities for earthwork/construction will be focused on earthworks in the Tailings Management Area for water management. It includes access road construction, tree clearing, and mass earth excavations for sumps and other water management features.

- Checks heavy equipment using approved circle check procedures before operating to ensure that mechanical, safety, and emergency equipment is in good working order.
- Operates hydraulic pumps, safety valves, and any other necessary mechanical components.
- Operates electrical, gasoline and diesel powered units.
- Adheres to workplace safety policies, regulations and compliances.
- Communicates any unsafe conditions or accidents/injuries in a timely manner to the supervisors in order to facilitate prompt correction or reporting.
- Disables cellular phones and other sources of distraction at all times while operating heavy equipment.

Requirements

- Must have previous experience operating at least one of the following heavy equipment: front end loaders, dozers, graders, and excavators
- Valid Drivers' License
- Strong communication skills
- Demonstrated leadership in safety is essential in this role
- Demonstrated leadership in environmental management, such as dealing with environmental spills, and sediment and erosion protection.

- Aptitude for mechanics with the ability to handle heavy machinery
