As the Senior Financial Officer, the successful candidate will be required to demonstrate extremely high standards of professionalism, accountability and autonomy.

Job Description:

The Director of Finance will be responsible for a wide range of duties, including supervision of all finance department staff, ensuring compliance with the First Nation's Financial Administration By-Law and all funding agreements, budget preparations, audit responsibilities, regular financial reporting and the overall management of the First Nation's finance department.

- A post-secondary degree or diploma in financial management or a related degree, with at least five (5) years of financial management experience or equivalent;

 - Advance Certificate in Accounting
- A certified Aboriginal Professional Administrator (CAPA) designation or be willing to obtain;
- Working knowledge of human resources management, and labour relations;
- A strong background in finance, including previous working knowledge of financial systems;
- Extensive knowledge of accounting practices and procedures, financial principles and concepts;
- Experience overseeing and monitoring budgets;
- Strategic and long-range planning skills;
- Sound decision-making skills and the ability to motivate your staff will also be crucial to your success in this position;
- Outstanding verbal and written communication skills as you will be interacting with a variety of stakeholders;
