Reporting to the Director of Addictions the National Native Alcohol and Drug Abuse Program (NNADAP) Worker works closely with the Suboxone Treatment Program Project Coordinator and other stakeholders in the implementation of a Community Based Opioid Addiction Treatment Program that includes the suboxone induction, tapering process and after care services.

PRIMARY ACCOUNTABILITIES

- Working collaboratively with stakeholders (i.e., healthcare providers, mental health workers, maternal & childcare workers, wellness workers, etc.) to implement and ensure the success of a Community Based Opioid Addiction Treatment Program.
- Participating in the delivery of programming.
- Supporting program participants, while demonstrating sensitivity and respect towards clients to understand and address their individual needs.
- Compiling information to prepare accurate reports as required.
- Promotes, monitors and maintains the health, safety and security of the program.
- Role modeling an alcohol and drug-free lifestyle.
- Participating in an on-call rotation.

POSITION REQUIREMENTS

- University degree or College diploma in social work or addictions counselling or another related field. Combination of experience and education may be considered.
- Preferred minimum of three to five (3-5) years experience in addiction and recovery services.
- Minimum of a Grade 12 education.
- Comprehensive knowledge of issues related to addiction and recovery.
- Knowledge of Rainy River First Nations and the community's culture, beliefs and traditional lifestyles.
- Must have excellent communication skills, both written and verbal.
- Satisfactory Criminal Record Check and vulnerable sector screening.
- Valid driver's license and satisfactory driver's abstract with access to reliable transportation to and from work.
- Adherence to Rainy River First Nations' Drug Testing Policy.
