To ensure the effective delivery of the Program such that the needs of the urban Indigenous children and youth (7-12 years) in the program are provided with tools and offered healthy activities which will build upon and foster their inherent ability to make healthy choices in a culturally sensitive manner.

Qualifications Include:

- Ideally possess a post-secondary education in Indigenous Studies, Social Work, Child and Youth Work, or a combination of the equivalent and relevant education.
- The candidate ideally will have a minimum of three years of demonstrated and related work experience with children and youth.
- Strong knowledge and awareness of Indigenous culture and history, with a particular emphasis on family violence, child welfare, the impacts of trauma, Indigenous youth engagement and community outreach.
- Ability to work professionally and collaboratively with child welfare agencies in Ontario.
- Strong understanding of the Child and Family Services Act and Ontario Children's Aid Societies with particular emphasis of impact on Indigenous families.
- Satisfactory vulnerable sector check.
- Valid G Driver's License.

35-hour work week, generally Monday to Friday 8:30-4:30 with scheduled evening and weekend work required for program delivery and special events. Flex hours provided in this position to allow targeted programs after-hours to students. Most work is indoors on-site at ANFC. Some programs are delivered in partnership with other agencies and, at times, are delivered off-site hosted by partner agencies. Some in-home visits to client's homes. Occasional outdoor program delivery required. Occasional overnight travel required within the province.

Salary is commensurate with education and experience. We offer benefits, additional paid holidays on top of the statutory holidays as well as two weeks off at Christmas break, plus an additional two weeks of vacation to start.
