Position Summary:

The Cultural Resource Worker is a full-time indefinite position. The Cultural Resource Worker is responsible for recommending traditional, culturally appropriate interventions for clients and community; to give direction to the Community Support Services Team in reflecting and using the values and beliefs of the traditional way in their practice and documentation. The Cultural Resource Worker is responsible for providing education and awareness for the prevention of family violence. All services provided must be consistent with the philosophy, approach, policies and procedures established by Nigigoonsiminikaaning First Nation.

* Please note that we have a female worker currently and it would be ideal to have a male person for this vacant position.

Qualifications:

- Ability to speak the Ojibwe Language
- Understanding of culture and traditions
- Knowledge, belief of traditional values gained through life experience
- Working knowledge of word processing
- Planning and time management skills
- Excellent interpersonal skills
- Good oral and written communication skills and ability to document detailed case notes
- Current First Aid and CPR certificates
- Ability to flex daily work hours as determined by the supervisor
- Must possess a valid Class "G" Ontario Driver's License and be willing to travel
- Must provide a clear criminal reference/vulnerable sector check and a driver's abstract
