The coordinator will develop programs that involve Elders, early childhood educators, teachers, students, ANFC coordinators, greenhouse volunteers, and knowledge carriers to co-deliver curriculum in local outdoor settings in a way that honours Indigenous values and ways of learning.

- Post-secondary education in Indigenous studies, social work, health studies, child and youth work or combination of education and relevant work experience
- Strong knowledge of and awareness of indigenous culture and history with emphasis on the impacts of trauma, family violence, Indigenous youth engagement and community outreach.
- Provide a culture-based approach to learning and activities
- Satisfactory vulnerable sector check

#### Work Conditions:

35-hour work week, Monday to Friday 8:30-4:30 with flex hours available, in keeping with internal policies and procedures. This position delivers programs at different locations and in partnership with other agencies. Outdoor program delivery required. Requires physical exertion to deliver quality programming. Occasional overnight travel required within the province for training.
