Reporting to the Director of Community Wellness, the Early Childhood Development Worker provides support for clients/members of the Rainy River First Nations and clients under the Aboriginal Healthy Babies Healthy Children (AHBHC).

Primary Accountabilities Include:

- Developing a trusting relationship with families and children and providing them with information about community resources/activities, parenting, healthy lifestyle choices and childcare options.
- Assisting mothers with obtaining proper pre and post natal care.
- Supporting families to create environments that encourage child development, which may include but is not limited to improving home safety and creating healthy routines such as mealtime, bath time and bedtime.
- Planning daily activities for the Child Resource Centre.
- Developing reports as requested.
- Liaising with associated agencies, Elders and applicable social, family services, health, drug and alcohol abuse, social assistance, recreation and education programs.

Position Requirements:

- Minimum Grade 12 Diploma or equivalent.
- Knowledge of the Aboriginal Healthy Babies Healthy Children program.
- Program management experience.
- Experience with developing activities and programs that will provide support for parents.
- Highly proficient in MS Office applications.
- Strong interpersonal, written and verbal communication skills.
- Ability to be creative when designing child development activities.
- Excellent organizational, time management and resource management skills.
- Knowledge of Rainy River First Nation or Treaty #3 and Anishinaabe culture.
