Position: Environmental Field Technician (2 positions available)

Start Date: mid-July 2023

Salary: \$20/hour at 37.5 hours/week for 5 weeks (\$3750 in total)

Job Description: AKRC will be carrying out a large field program this summer to catch up to 140 Walleye from five lakes within the Traditional Territories of our member communities. Fish tissue samples will be collected and submitted for mercury analysis. The results will be used to look at safe levels of fish to eat. You will be involved in project planning, fish collection and sampling, as well as helping us communicate the program to each Nation. You will be part of a larger project team, that will provide training and support throughout the program. **This is a great way to be part of a very important project for all AKRC member Nations.**

Duties and Responsibilities:

- o fieldwork, and
- o some report writing.
