Qualifications

The ideal candidate will possess a post-secondary education in Indigenous Studies, Social Work, Child and Youth Work or a combination of the equivalent and relevant education.

The candidate will ideally have

- A minimum of three years of demonstrated and related work experience with children and youth.
- Strong knowledge and awareness of Indigenous culture and history, with a particular emphasis on family violence, child welfare, the impacts of trauma, Indigenous youth engagement and community outreach.
- Ability to work professionally and collaboratively with child welfare agencies in Ontario.
- Strong understanding of the Child and Family Services Act and Ontario Children's Aid Societies with particular emphasis of impact on Indigenous families.
- Understanding and knowledge of Abinoojii Inakonigewin.

- A satisfactory vulnerable sector check is required.
- A valid 'G' Driver's License is required.

Work Conditions

35 hours per week, Monday to Friday 8:30-4:30 with some occasional evening and weekend work required for special events. Most work is indoors at ANFC site(s) although there are land-based activities required to effectively deliver this program. Some programs are delivered in partnership with other agencies and, at times, are delivered off-site hosted by other agencies. Some in-home visits with clients are required. Some land-based and outdoor program delivery is required. Occasional overnight travel is required for training, within the province.

Salary is based on a 35-hour work week and benefits are available following successful completion of probation. We offer benefits, additional paid holidays on top of the statutory holidays and two weeks off at Christmas.
